

CP OF NYS AFFILIATES COLLABORATE ON ART EXHIBITION

An exhibition of artwork by artists representing three CP of NYS Affiliates is on display in a New York City gallery through Labor Day. More than 80 works by 73 artists from Queens Centers for Progress, United Cerebral Palsy of New York City and Cerebral Palsy Associations of New York State-Metro Services will be on display until September 7 at the Gallery RIVAA, 527 Main Street on Roosevelt Island.

The exhibition was first envisioned by New York State Assembly Member Micah Kellner of Manhattan. Assembly Member Kellner greeted nearly 200 people who attended a pre-opening reception at the gallery on August 13. He also met with artists and members of their families during the evening.

"As someone with Cerebral Palsy myself, I was especially proud to welcome this exhibition to Roosevelt Island," said Kellner. "There is a stunning range of talent on display in this show, and it has been an honor to work with RIVAA and these three outstanding organizations to help make it a reality. It's really a thrill to see how beautifully the artists have brought their visions to life, and Roosevelt Island, with its tradition of accessibility to people with disabilities, is the perfect place for it."
