**UNITED CEREBRAL PALSY OF LONG ISLAND ARTIST WINS CP of NYS  
VISIONS OF NEW YORK STATEWIDE ART CONTEST**

**Cohoes, NY** – Robert, an artist representing United Cerebral Palsy of Long Island, has been named the winner of the 2018 Cerebral Palsy Associations of New York State (CP of NYS) ***Visions of New York*** Art Contest. This is the 15<sup>th</sup> year of the contest, which highlights artwork created by people with disabilities from CP of NYS Affiliates across the state.

The winning entry, ***Venice at its Best***, will be the centerpiece of the annual commemorative poster highlighting artwork from 20 other CP of NYS Affiliates. Robert is described as a quiet man with a natural talent who has become a prolific painter and loves the studio atmosphere. He will be recognized at the organization’s Annual Conference Keynote Luncheon on Monday, October 15th at the Saratoga Hilton Hotel in downtown Saratoga Springs.
